

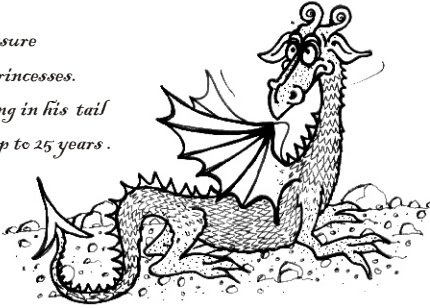
Arkan Sonney (erkin sonna)

Tsuricaune

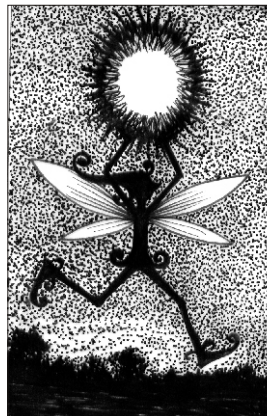
